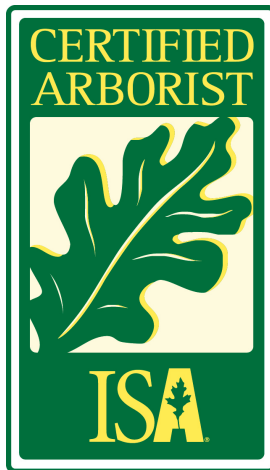

| <p>Crown cleaning: is the most basic level of tree pruning and includes the removal of dead, dying, diseased and broken branches</p> <p>Crown thinning: is the selective removal of branches to increase light penetration and air movement through the crown of the tree.</p> <p>Crown elevation: consists of pruning or removing lower branches or limbs to provide vertical clearance.</p> <p>Crown reduction: is used to clear tree branches from objects such as buildings, signs or lights.</p> <p>Crown restoration: is usually the necessary type of pruning for trees that have sustained damage from storms or have been vandalized.</p> <p>Espalier pruning: is rarely seen on this side of the Atlantic Ocean, but was common in Europe where small courtyards could accommodate trees, if they were pruned to stay tight against a wall.</p> | | | |
